The Blumen Room is a private space set with comfortable chairs and a changing station to the north of the sanctuary, and down the hall to the right.

### CHILDREN DISMISSED TO CHILDREN'S CHURCH

### SCRIPTURE READING | Revelation 2:18-29 | Dave Boland

"And to the angel of the church in Thyatira write: 'The words of the Son of God, who has eyes like a flame of fire, and whose feet are like burnished bronze, <sup>19</sup>"'I know your works, your love and faith and service and patient endurance, and that your latter works exceed the first. <sup>20</sup>But I have this against you, that you tolerate that woman Jezebel, who calls herself a prophetess and is teaching and seducing my servants to practice sexual immorality and to eat food sacrificed to idols.<sup>21</sup> gave her time to repent. but she refuses to repent of her sexual immorality. <sup>22</sup>Behold, I will throw her onto a sickbed, and those who commit adultery with her I will throw into great tribulation, unless they repent of her works, <sup>23</sup> and I will strike her children dead. And all the churches will know that I am he who searches mind and heart, and I will give to each of you according to your works. <sup>24</sup>But to the rest of you in Thyatira, who do not hold this teaching, who have not learned what some call the deep things of Satan, to you I say. I do not lay on you any other burden. <sup>25</sup>Only hold fast what you have until I come. <sup>26</sup>The one who conquers and who keeps my works until the end, to him I will give authority over the nations, <sup>27</sup> and he will rule them with a rod of iron, as when earthen pots are broken in pieces, even as I myself have received authority from my Father. <sup>28</sup>And I will give him the morning star. <sup>29</sup>He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches.'

PARTAKING OF THE ELEMENTS

The Lord's Supper, also called Communion or the Eucharist, is the family meal of Christians. If you are not a Christian, or if you are not prepared to share in this meal, we encourage you to spend this time in prayer. ### **Building Update**

**Inspections** showed the building presenting well for its age, apart from needing two HVAC units and some minor repairs. **Mortgage** has been approved! We are in the process of collecting pledges for funding. Due diligence period ends September 9th, with closing expected around October 9th. **Fundraising** has one-time gifts at \$1.328M, with \$172k needed for the goal of \$1.5M. Monthly gifts are at \$7,680, with \$3,420 needed for the goal of \$11,000.
